

**Sarah Leo, Vice President of Corporate Development, Nunatsiavut Group of Companies**

Ms. Leo was appointed to the C-CORE Board of Directors in 2020.

She is the Vice President of Corporate Development at the Nunatsiavut Group of Companies (NGC). In this role, she works with the heads of NGC fully-owned companies and partnerships, and oversees the day-to-day operations of those entities. She manages NGC's relationships with its key stakeholders, including Beneficiaries, with industry and all levels of government.

Prior to joining NGC in 2017, Ms. Leo was Aboriginal Affairs Superintendent with Vale for the Voisey's Bay mine. She also served as the Executive Director of OKâlaKatiget from 2010 to 2012.

In addition to her corporate expertise, Ms. Leo has extensive public service experience, having served a four-year term as President of Nunatsiavut (2012-2016) and a four-year term as Mayor of AngajukKak, Nain Inuit Community Government (2012-2016).

Ms. Leo's early career was as a 21-year member of the Canadian Armed Forces. She now serves as the Honorary Colonel for 444 Combat Support Squadron out of 5 Wing Goose Bay.

Ms. Leo is a trustee for the Labrador Inuit Settlement Trust, a board member for CBDC Labrador and a member of the BMO Indigenous Advisory Council. She was born and raised, and now lives again, in Nain, Nunatsiavut.
